Coaches Expectations

Coach Expectations

- I will not use profanity in the course of my duties as a coach.
- I will only allow Eastmont School District registered students that are cleared for my program to participate.
- I will follow athletic office eligibility communications and not take an athlete's word on eligibility.
- I will not transport any athlete in my personal car without AD's knowledge/clearance.
- I will not spend any money or commit to any expense without an authorized PO and expect to get reimbursed without AD's approval.
- I will not allow any adult to coach or interact with any of the athletes without prior clearance in the athletic office. I know that volunteers must be 21 years of age.
- I will not talk to any athlete or parent about any other athlete/parent.
- I will not speak badly in any public setting about any coaches or administrators involved at Eastmont School District.
- I will not collect money on behalf of Eastmont School District from kids/parents for anything other than approved fundraisers.
- I will not have students out of school without an accurate list of those missing to the athletic and attendance office.
- I will keep all confrontations between adults for private environments. Athletes will not hear coaches argue or have emotional outbursts with other adults.
- I will supervise my athletes before, during and after practice/events until picked up by their parents.
- I will attend the pre-season meeting, kickoff and awards night for my sport.
- I will report my scores/results to the athletic office.
- I will ensure all doors are locked; gym clean and lights out prior to exiting the building.
- I will not give my keys to any student/athlete.
- I understand that I am a representative of the district and my behaviors and actions will be in accordance with that responsibility.
- I understand that there is an out-of-season in which I may not coach present or future squad members.
- I will take daily attendance and keep documentation of competition for each athlete.
- I will not communicate personally with students via social media outlets. I understand the use of district approved messaging (ParentSquare or Final Forms) is acceptable for athletes to communicate an absence, lateness, etc. It is not for personal communication or one-on-one communication between coach and athlete.
