CTE Pathways

Students in Washington must complete 3 standards to be able to graduate

- 1. Meet the 24 credit requirements
- 2. Annually complete the High School and Beyond Plan
- 3. Meet one of the following graduation pathways:
 - a. Pass English and Math sections of the SBAC
 - b. Pass one of the following tests at the required cut score SAT or ACT or ASVAB
 - c. Earn college credit 100 level courses or higher in both English and Math
 - d. Pass AP classes with a C+ or AP tests with a 3 (or higher) in English and Math
 - e. Earn **2 credits** in a mixed series of CTE courses or 2.0 credits from the same CTE program area (Agriculture, Business, Family Consumer Science, Skilled & Tech, STEM, Work-Based Learning, Health Science, or ASL).



CTE courses that will meet the 2.0 credit requirements are listed below. Check with your counselor to adjust your schedule if you have not met your Graduation Pathway requirement.
