

RUNNING START STUDENT/PARENT CONTRACT

Eastmont High School

All students planning to enroll in Running Start must have a signed contract on file before an EHS counselor can sign the Enrollment Verification Form (EVF)

AS A RUNNING START STUDENT, I UNDERSTAND THAT:

- I am subject to all rules, regulations, and procedures governing college students for course requirements, content, registration, grading and appropriate behavior
- I am responsible for managing my class schedule between the college and Eastmont High School, such that when I register for my college courses they will not conflict with my high school schedule - and that also includes Late Start Mondays
- I understand that I need to give my EHS Counselor 48 hours to complete the EVF form submitted each quarter
- It is my responsibility to seek information about EHS events via the website and to check my EHS school email regularly
- EHS runs on a semester system and WVC changes classes quarterly so I will need to adjust accordingly to both yearly calendars
- It is my responsibility to work with the WVC staff (not the EHS Counselors) on creating and following the two-year plan for the Associates degree
- I must maintain a minimum 2.0 GPA each quarter at WVC otherwise I run the risk of academic probation/suspension or expulsion
- The grades I earn begin my college GPA and they become a permanent part of my high school transcript, therefore, this GPA will follow me throughout the remainder of my high school years and into my college career
- As an athlete I must meet WIAA eligibility requirements to participate in Eastmont's sport programs
- If I do not complete the equivalent courses for the EHS diploma by the end of winter quarter, I will not receive my high school diploma at graduation but will be able to pick it up after spring Running Start grades are posted to the transcript

AS THE PARENT/GUARDIAN OF A RUNNING START STUDENT, I UNDERSTAND THAT:

- I will not be notified of my student's chosen classes, attendance or grades
- The Running Start program will fund 100+ level classes only - all additional expenses such as books, parking, labs and registration fee are the responsibility of the student/parent
- If my student does not follow the WVC Add/Drop process this may result in having to pay for the tuition those courses as they may not be covered by Running Start funding
- Transportation to and from the college is not provided by the Eastmont School District and is the student/parent responsibility
- If my student does not complete the equivalent courses for their EHS diploma by the end of winter quarter, they will not receive their high school diploma at graduation but will be able to pick it up after spring Running Start grades are posted to the transcript
