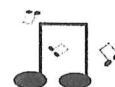

Dear Music Department Instructors, School Counselors and Scholarship Advisors,

My name is Peg Ronhovde, and I am a member of the Wenatchee Valley Appleaires, a community women's vocal ensemble. Each year we award a music scholarship to a graduating senior who will be entering their first year of college and who will be pursuing a degree in music. This may be music education, performance, music therapy or arts management for example.

This year's scholarship award is \$2,000. The competition is open to high school seniors who are U.S. citizens living in the Greater Wenatchee area, Chelan and Douglas counties, of Washington state.

Applicants will perform for a panel of judges chosen from the Wenatchee area pool of musicians. Applicants will be required to perform two pieces, preferably accompanied, that demonstrate a range of styles, genre, and musical abilities. Judges will ask a few questions of the applicant to determine their knowledge of music and their instrument or voice. They will also ask them to talk about their future plans and goals in a music career.

Students must submit **1. A completed copy of the application form, 2. A copy of their high school transcript and 3. One letter of recommendation** from a high school principal, music teacher, private music teacher or school counselor.
