Level 1: Draw a picture that could be included in this newspaper. Add a short *caption so readers know what is going on in your *image.

Level 2: Write an article that could be included in this newspaper. Write it from the *point of view of anybody within your household. For example, your younger sibling, your dog, your mom, yourself, etc!

Level 3: *Collaborate with others in your class to put together a *multiple article newspaper to be turned in! Include pictures, titles for each article, a name for your newspaper and anything else you and your partners can think of! This can also be done by yourself if you do not want to partner up here :).

*Hints and Explanations:

Accessed- where you got it and how they can get it. **Collaborate-** work together

Caption- the information under a picture/photo that tells more about it.

Image- picture or drawing **Point of view-** a persons way of looking at the story

Multiple article- more than one article (in your newspaper)
