CALL TO ORDER & PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

BUILDING AND PROGRAM REPORT

A. Clovis Point Staff Recognition.

Director Eggers recognized Clovis Point Intermediate School Staff for the following accomplishments:

- 1. Clovis Point's Guidance Team meets weekly to discuss Tier 2 & Tier 3 students. They problem solve how to best assist these at-risk students. The PBIS Committee meets regularly to collaborate and problem solve how to best assist all students with their SEL needs.
- 2. Clovis Point has implemented an Inclusion program for their Special Education students building wide.
- 3. All students receive daily instruction in Science and Social Studies, as well as a double period block instruction in Math and ELA. In addition, all students are receiving Enrichment Reading and in some cases Math.
- 4. Math is Cool Grade 5 received 1st place; Math is Cool Grade 6 received 1st place; and Math is Cool Grade 7 received 2nd place.

B. Clovis Point Intermediate School Building Report.

Principal Bob Celebrezze and Clovis Point School staff shared information on their recent challenges and accomplishments. They answered questions from the Board.

NOTIFICATION OF RIGHTS UNDER FERPA FOR ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOLS (FERPA)

for Elementary and Secondary Schools

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) affords parents and students over 18 years of age ("eligible students") certain rights with respect to the student's education records. These rights are:

- 1) The right to inspect and review the student's education record within 45 days of the day the School receives a request for access.
 - Parents or eligible students should submit to the School principal [or appropriate school official] a written request that identifies the record(s) they wish to inspect. The School official will make arrangements for access and notify the parent or eligible student of the time and place where the records may be inspected.
- 2) The right to request the amendment of the student's education records that the parent or eligible student believes are inaccurate.
 - Parents or eligible students may ask the School to amend a record that they believe is inaccurate. They should write the School principal [or appropriate school official], clearly identify the part of the record they want changed, and specify why it is inaccurate. If the School decides not to amend the record as requested by the parent or eligible student, the School will notify the parent or eligible student of the decision and advise them of their right to a hearing regarding the request for amendment. Additional information regarding the hearing procedures will be provided to the parent or eligible student when notified of the right to a hearing.
- 3) The right to consent to disclosure of personally identifiable information contained in the student's education records, except to the extent that FERPA authorizes disclosure without consent.
 - One exception, which permits disclosure without consent, is disclosure to school officials with legitimate educational interest. A school official is a person employed by the School as an administrator, supervisor, instructor, or support staff member (including health or medical staff and law enforcement unit personnel); a person serving on the School Board; a person or company whom the School has contracted to perform a special task (such as an attorney, auditor, medical consultant, or therapist); or a parent of a student serving on an official committee, such as a disciplinary or grievance committee, or assisting another school official in performing his or her tasks.

A school official has a legitimate educational interest if the official needs to review an educational record in order to fulfill his or her professional responsibility.

Upon request, the School disclosed education records without consent to officials of another school district in which a student seeks or intends to enroll. [NOTE: FERPA requires a school district to make a reasonable attempt to notify the parent or student of the records request unless it states in its annual notification that it intends to forward records on request.]

4) The right to file a complaint with the U.S. Department of Education concerning alleged failures by the Eastmont Public Schools to comply with the requirements of FERPA.

Admission/Withdrawal and Attendance Policies

All students need to register for school at the Eastmont School District office at 800 Eastmont Avenue.

Kindergarten Requirements: To enter the kindergarten a child must be five years of age on or before August 31. Birth certificates or hospital records and an immunization record must be presented before students may register. State education officials require a polio immunization series, a series for "DTP" (diphtheria, tetanus, and pertussis) or a DT variation, two immunizations against mumps, measles and rubella, and the series of three Hepatitis B immunizations for kindergarteners through fourth grade prior to school admission. The final immunizations for the polio and DTP series must have been administered on or after the child's fourth birthday. Kindergarteners are also required to have the varicella immunization or proof of having had the disease. Immunization records will be reviewed for compliance by School District nurses.

Withdrawal: The school appreciates notice of pupil withdrawal at least two days before the last day of attendance indicating:

- 1. The last day of attendance.
- 2. Approximate location to which you are moving.
- 3. If known, the new school your child will attend.

Upon enrollment of your child at a new school, the new school will request permanent records to be sent. With a reasonable notice, the teacher can prepare the progress report and obtain information for the transfer. Parents should stop in at the office to obtain a copy of their child's immunization records to present to the new school.

Attendance Policy: Attendance is essential to the success of all students. Students who miss critical instruction in key concepts quickly fall behind in school and are less likely to achieve academic success. Accordingly, school attendance is mandatory, and unexcused absences and truancy are prohibited. The state defines chronic absenteeism as 10% of days enrolled in school.

It is required by state law that each absence from school be explained by a note or phone call from the parent or guardian. Parents are required to contact the office as soon as possible each time their child is absent and include the students complete name, date and reason for the absence. If we do not hear from you, our receptionist will call you to verify the absence (required by the Becca Bill).

Parents who choose to have their children miss school for non-illness or non-emergency reasons should contact the school at least one week in advance of the absence to complete the pre-approved absence form. These absences may be considered unexcused if they cause a serious adverse effect on the

student's educational progress. Parents whose children incur more than two unexcused absences during any quarter will be asked to meet with the principal to develop a plan to improve attendance.

Tardies	Students are expected to be in class on time. If a student arrives after the second bell, they will need to check in at the office. When a student's tardiness becomes frequent or disruptive, the student will be referred to the principal, assistant principal or the counselor.	
Early Checkout	All students need to be checked out of school through the office. Only people listed in our data system will be allowed to pick up students during the school day. ID is required. We request that you do not remove your child from school during the school day unless it is absolutely necessary, and early checkout within 15 minutes from the end of the day is not permitted.

Classroom Learning Environment		
Birthdays at	Birthday treats may be brought to school, please check with the teacher in advance.

School	 Party invitations and gifts are not allowed to be passed out at school unless every class member is invited. We do not allow flower arrangements or balloons for student birthdays in the classrooms.
Cell Phones and Personal Electronic Devices	 Cell phones are discouraged, but if parents believe one is necessary for their child for communication reasons, the phone must be turned off and kept out of sight at all times during the school day. If it becomes a disruption, the parent or student will need to pick it up in the office. This includes smart watches with phone capabilities. Students are not allowed to use or possess any other personal electronic devices at school. They will be confiscated until the end of the day. If the problem continues, further action will be taken. Exceptions may be made if devices are for educational purposes and if they are pre-approved. The school is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
Toys	 All toys should be kept at home except if brought for "Show & Tell" purposes with advanced permission given by the teacher. Toys can cause a disruption to learning and are often lost or stolen.

Food

Breakfast and Lunches: Eastmont School District has a breakfast and hot lunch program. Students may also bring their lunches from home and may purchase ½ pints of milk.

- Meals may be purchased on a daily, weekly, or monthly basis by either sending money to school with your student or using the online School Cafe service (recommended).
- The cost for meals will be published and sent home at the beginning of the year.
- This information may also be accessed on the District website, <u>www.eastmont206.org</u>, under "Food Service."
- Applications for free and reduced price breakfasts and lunches are available in the school office.
- Students will be allowed to "charge" meals even if they do not have any money in their accounts and parents will be responsible to pay for these meals.

Lunches/ Snack from home	 Students are not allowed to share or trade food for safety reasons. Only individual sized portions may be brought to school for lunch/snack (no large bag of chips, cookies, crackers, candy, etc) Soda pop and energy drinks are not permitted during lunch or snack.
Candy/Gum	 Candy, gum and other treats may be allowed only at teacher discretion for special events or celebrations.

Health Services

Our school Health Room is staffed by paraprofessionals, office staff, and is overseen by a part-time school nurse. When students come to the Health Room, staff assess the problem, treat minor injuries, document the visit and call parents when necessary.

Accidents

During the school year there are occasionally a few accidents. Every precaution is taken to prevent such mishaps. It is very important for each student and parent to know the following procedure in case of an accident:

- The student reports the accident to the teacher or playground supervisor.
- The student will be brought to the Health Room. If the injury is serious, parents will be contacted. Unless it is an absolute emergency, the school cannot take the child to a doctor.
- If you have school insurance, please ask the office staff for an accident report to take to the doctor.

Allergies

If your child has any special health considerations or food allergies, please share that information with your child's teacher, the school office, and/or the school nurse. **Students with food allergies:**

- Must have an Emergency Care Plan in place and have necessary, up to date medications at school
- Should not receive any treats or foods at school unless provided by their parents or food services.
- If you have any questions or concerns please contact the school nurses at 888-1480.

Cold/Wet Weather

Students will be outside for recess unless the temperature is below 15 degrees. Please make sure your students are dressed appropriately. Unless a student has a doctor's note, they will need to go outside. Students will have outdoor recess when it rains and may use umbrellas during this time.

Infectious Disease and Lice

Head lice are often a fact of life for school-aged children. While inconvenient, head lice cause no medical harm and can be effectively treated.

If a child is found to have head lice, the following will occur:

- 1. The child's parent or guardian will be notified by telephone or letter home stating that prompt, proper treatment of this condition is in the best interest of the child.
- 2. The parents of the affected students will be given the handout "Parents Guide How to Treat and Keep Lice Out of Hair" which has accurate information about the diagnosis, treatment and prevention of head lice.
- 3. It is the practice of Eastmont School District that healthy children will not be excluded from or miss school because of head lice.

Illness	Students who become ill during the school day are sent to the office. The office staff will determine whether or not the student should be sent home. • Anytime a child's temperature is 100 degrees or higher, we will automatically call his/her parent. • A child should remain home if he/she has had a fever and/or is vomiting within the last 24 hours.
Medication at School	State laws prohibit us from giving any medications (over-the-counter or prescribed) without having the following form completed:, "Authorization for Administration of Medication at School." This form must be filled out and signed by your healthcare provider and parent. These forms are available in the school office.
School Insurance	Parents may buy an insurance policy that covers injury received by the child during the school day. Brochures will be sent home so that parents who wish may purchase this coverage.
Vision and Hearing	Vision and hearing screening is done yearly for grades K-3. If a problem is detected, parents will be notified as soon as possible.

School Safety

Student safety is one of the most important aspects of what we do at Eastmont.

Bikes, Skateboards, Scooters, and Shoes with Wheels

3rd/4th grade students may ride bikes/scooters with helmets to/from school but are not allowed to ride them on school grounds or in the parking lot during school hours.

- We encourage children to lock their bicycles to the racks provided.
- Students may not ride skateboards to school and may not wear shoes with wheels.
- Bicycles and scooters on the sidewalks cause a real safety concern for parents, students and staff entering and leaving the buildings. Therefore, we require bikes and scooters to be walked when on school grounds.

Emergency Drills

- Fire and other emergency drills are scheduled on a regular basis in accordance with state law.
- Earthquake drills, emergency evacuation drills and lockdown drills are also practiced regularly throughout the year.

Harassment, Intimidation, Bullying (Board Policy)

The Eastmont School District is committed to a safe and civil school environment for all students, employees, volunteers and patrons, free from harassment, intimidation and bullying. "Harassment, intimidation or bullying" means any intentional written, verbal, or physical act, including, but not limited to one shown to be motivated by any characteristic in RCS 9A.36.080(3), (race, religion, ancestry, national origin, gender, sexual orientation or mental or physical disability), or other distinguishing characteristics, when the intentional written, verbal, or physical act:

- Physically harms a student or damages the student's property; or
- Has the effect of substantially interfering with a student's education; or
- Is so severe, persistent, or pervasive that it creates an intimidating or threatening educational environment; or
- Has the effect of substantially disrupting the orderly operation of the school.

Harassment, intimidation, or bullying can take many forms including: slurs, rumors, jokes, innuendos, demeaning comments, drawings, cartoons, pranks, gestures, physical attacks, threats, or other written, oral or physical actions. "Intentional acts" refers to the individual's choice to engage in the act rather than the ultimate impact of the action(s).

Board Policy 3207 is a component of the district's responsibility to create and maintain a safe, civil, respectful and inclusive learning community, and is to be implemented in conjunction with comprehensive training of staff and volunteers, including the education of students in partnership with families and the community.

Eastmont School Board Policy 3207 outlines the Informal and Formal Complaint process. Please notify the Principal of any acts of harassment, intimidation or bullying, and either the informal or formal complaint process will be explained to you. Action will be taken immediately to stop the undesired behavior.

Is it bullying? We are using this definition to help students understand the difference between mean, rude, and bullying behavior: • When someone says or does something unintentionally hurtful and they do it once, that's RUDE. • When someone says or does something intentionally hurtful and they do it once, that's MEAN. When someone says or does something intentionally hurtful and they keep doing it - even when asked to stop or are upset - that's BULLYING. Possession or • Students in the Eastmont School District are not allowed to possess or use any Use of tobacco products, alcohol, illegal drugs, weapons or pseudo-weapons while Tobacco attending school or school functions. Products, Weapons and pseudo-weapons shall include any item construed to be a Alcohol, Drugs weapon, including, but not limited to: "switch-blade" combs, replicas of guns, or Weapons knives, throwing stars, and num-chuks. • Use or possession of such products will result in disciplinary action up to expulsion, and immediate contact of parents and/or law enforcement officials School Inclement weather may cause school to begin late, or school may be cancelled for the Closure Due to day. For information on school closures: Weather. • Our school website and the district's website at www.eastmont206.org will have Inside Recess any school closure information and will be updated by 6:30AM in the morning. Media will be notified immediately of ANY type of school schedule change • You may also call the District Snow Line at 888-1111. • Please do NOT call the school. Telephone lines must be kept open in case of an emergency. Students will remain indoors when the outdoor temperature drops below 15 degrees or when air quality is deemed dangerous. The district office makes the decision as to when we remain inside for air quality. Students will go outside when it is raining or snowing, so proper outdoor clothing is essential. Technology/ All students will be given internet access, unless parents opt their child out using the Internet Parent Release and Student Use Form (#2022-F2) Access and Student projects, classroom activities, and student work may be showcased on the Web school or district websites and social media pages. Only relevant information will be **Publishing** included (ie:first name, picture, participation, grade level, etc...) Parents may opt out of this option. Visitors -Allowing our students to bring other children to school causes a disruption to learning **Students** and is a liability issue. Therefore, we must deny any such requests.

Technology/ Internet Safety

Students must agree to the following rules for using technology:

- 1. I will not let other students use my name and password.
- 2. I will not use bad language or pictures.
- 3. I will respect others.
- 4. I will follow all school rules while using the computer.
- 5. I understand that all my computer work will be checked by the teacher and computer privileges will be revoked if I break the computer rules.
- 6. I will not damage the computer and will stay in my own area on the computer.
- 7. Downloading of any programs, games, music or any other software is strictly prohibited.

If devices are damaged due to negligent use by the student, repair and or replacement costs may be charged to the student's account.

Threat/ Threat Assessment

- Students may not threaten to hurt or kill another person or threaten to cause damage to the school.
- As in airports and other public places, these kinds of words, joking or otherwise, are absolutely not allowed. The safety of students is our top priority at school.
- Threats to kill or cause bodily injury to people or destroy property will be taken seriously.
- Depending on the seriousness and nature of the threat, a student may be detained, sent home from school, or separated from others while a threat assessment is completed.
- Police may be contacted.

Volunteers and Parent Visitation

ALL volunteers are required to fill out a Volunteer Disclosure Form, available at www.eastmont206.org - District Information - Parents & Community - Volunteer Application. These forms must be renewed each school year.

- Parents and other adults are encouraged to volunteer. Please make arrangements with the teacher if you wish to volunteer.
- Parents are welcome to visit the classroom. Prior arrangements need to be made with the classroom teacher.
- Please check in at the office and obtain a visitor pass when you arrive at school to let us know a visitor is on campus.

Weapon Free Zone

All Washington schools have been officially defined as weapon-free zones. The law has no provision for the age of offenders, so even a kindergartner is expected to know enough to realize that they should never bring a gun or dangerous weapon to school. Squirt guns and any other toy replicas of weapons are also strictly prohibited.

Custody Documents/ Parenting Plan	Refer to Eastmont School Board Policy 3126 • Questions regarding custody issues and disputes should be referred to your attorney. • Schools do not have the authority to enforce Parenting Plans
Directory Information	 Most information about Eastmont School District students cannot be made public without consent of parents or guardians. Federal law prohibits schools from releasing information without permission, except for what is termed "directory information." Directory information about students may be released by the district without parental consent. The school district will not release directory information for commercial purposes. Directory information is defined as the student's name, photograph, address, grade level, dates of attendance, participation in officially recognized activities and sports, weight and height of members of athletic teams, diplomas and awards received and the most recent previous school attended. Photos of students are sometimes used in district or school-produced publications or for use by the news media. The district takes special care not to identify the photographed students by name in most cases. However, published photos in yearbooks, student/school newspapers, school handbooks, etc., are considered public domain and can be reproduced by the media. Parents/guardians who do not want their student directory information released complete the "FERPA Do Not Disclose Student Directory Information Form" on our district's website.
Duplicate Student Information	 We try to be sensitive to the needs of all family structures, while maintaining a neutral environment for our students. If your child is part of a multiple household family and double notices/ information is preferred, please note that when registering or let the office know. We will send duplicates home for anything we mail, but are not able to replicate the items carried home by students. We request that parents meet together for school conferences.
Enrollment Cards and Emergency Information	 Each year we send home an Enrollment Card Update Form and Health Information Form for you to complete. It is extremely important that both of these be filled out and returned to school immediately. The card provides the information necessary to reach you if your child should become ill or be injured at school. If there are any changes in your address, phone, or emergency contacts during the year, please call the office with your new information.

Lost and Found	 We have a designated lost and found area that we encourage parents to check often. Please mark all clothing with your child's name, marked clothing helps facilitate identification and return. Students are responsible to look for their own lost items. Parents are also welcome to come to this area to look for lost items. Periodically articles are donated to various charitable organizations. We are not responsible for any lost items. 	
Pictures	It is a tradition in our district to have individual and group pictures taken. A commercial photographer takes these pictures and makes them available to students and parents for a fee. The individual pictures are taken in the fall and the class pictures are taken in the spring.	
Student Records	We maintain student records necessary for the educational guidance and welfare of our students, for orderly and efficient operation of school, and as required by law. This information is treated in a professional and confidential manner.

Transportation

Parents and Guardians:

Please discuss these bus passenger rules and procedures with your child. Your child should appreciate the important part he/she plays in accomplishing SAFE and EFFICIENT district transportation.

Your child should understand that riding a school bus is a privilege conditioned on appropriate, safe, respectful behavior. Unruly conduct on the bus is a very real risk to the safe operation of a school bus.

Your cooperation in communicating this very important message would be most appreciated.

Bus Service Eligibility	 All students are required to walk up to a one radius mile from their school. Bus service is provided beyond the one radius mile for all grades. Exceptions are made only when safety concerns are identified by the transportation office. In order to change their normal bus and/or stop, students must obtain a pass from the school office.
En Route to Bus Stop	Parents/guardians are encouraged to review their child's walking route to the bus stop, advising about safety concerns.
Be Prompt	 Bus passengers should arrive at the bus stop 5-10 minutes before the bus is scheduled to arrive. Buses will promptly depart all schools 5-10 minutes after dismissal times. For safety, once bus doors are closed, drivers will not stop for late arriving students.
At the Bus Stop	 While waiting at the bus stop, students are expected to stand a safe distance from the street and avoid activities that could injure themselves or others. Students are expected to respect others' property, however, bus stops are not supervised and parents are responsible for supervision until students are under the supervision of the driver. When the bus approaches, students must observe the instructions of the driver. This is particularly important in the winter when slick road conditions exist.
Boarding/ Departing the Bus	 It may be necessary to cross the road to board the bus. Students are expected to observe the driver's instructions and always cross in front of the bus with the aid of the flashing stop sign lights and crossing arm.
Driver Authority	 The driver has full authority over the passengers on the bus. Seating assignments may be necessary to assure passenger safety. If inappropriate behavior is demonstrated by a student, the parent will be contacted to assist the student to modify the behavior of concern.

Passenger Conduct

Safe, respectful conduct is expected of all passengers to insure safety:

- Obey the driver's instructions when first requested.
- Remain seated.
- Respect others and their property.
- Keep your hands to yourself.
- Keep noise level down.
- Cell phone use is not permitted on the bus.

Serious or persistent violations offensive to, or endangering the safety of others will result in progressive discipline. The age and experience of the student will help determine how many progressive steps are appropriate. Certain activities may result in immediate suspension from bus riding privileges. These include but are not limited to:

- Fighting on the bus
- Throwing objects in or out of the bus
- Possession of dangerous weapons or articles
- Destroying or defacing district or private property
- Use of sparking devices
- Smoking, or use/possession of drugs, alcohol or any form of tobacco
- Obscene gestures or profanity directed at the bus driver or others
- Any part of the body extended outside of the bus
- Assault on a bus driver will result in indefinite suspension and possible criminal charges
- Pointing a laser pointer at a bus driver will result in suspension from the bus and possible criminal charges

Accidents/ Breakdowns

- Bus drivers are thoroughly trained in defensive driving techniques and buses are carefully maintained.
- Yet, given the thousands of miles traveled annually, and the traffic conditions in our area, accidents and breakdowns can happen.
- All the buses have two-way radios and help can be just minutes away. One of the most important things to a bus driver in the event of an accident or breakdown is passenger cooperation.

Snow Days

• Detailed emergency snow route information is distributed at the school. Local radio will provide up-to-date information each morning when the roads are slick and snowy. Ask driver in advance if your route could be affected and how.

Items Not Allowed on the Bus

For reasons of safety and health and in order to comply with state law and district policies, the following items are not allowed on a school bus:

- 1. Glass objects; bottles, jars, etc.
- 2. Open containers of food, drink, gum
- 3. Inflated balloons
- 4. Live animals, bugs, worms
- 5. Plants, dirt, other growing projects

- 6. Oversized objects and instruments; those that cannot fit safely in the seat with the student
- 7. Weapons; guns, knives, razor blades, etc. (real or toy)
- 8. Sports equipment which could endanger others; like javelins, pole vaults or shot puts
- 9. Skateboards, scooters, and baseball bats
- 10. Any item which cannot be transported easily or which creates a safety concern
- 11. Distracting electronic devices such as Game Boys or MP3 players, or trading cards

Please arrange for alternative transportation if any of the above need to go to or from school.

Student Discipline on the Bus

The district has adopted a progressive discipline policy which emphasizes logical consequences for inappropriate behavior.

- The written tool for this is the "Bus Conduct Notice." If warranted, your child will be issued a written notice for you to review and sign. If a notice is issued, the transportation director may attempt to call you to confirm and to answer any questions you may have. You may be asked to accompany your student for a conference with the driver and the transportation director.
- Camera boxes are mounted in district buses. Cameras are randomly and/or selectively rotated through the buses. Student behavior may be monitored or observed from the video system. Parents may view a video concerning their student by contacting the transportation director.
- Parents are encouraged to contact the Director any time they have concerns. If appropriate, a conference with other parties including the student and the driver may be arranged.
- The District reserves the right to suspend transportation privileges for any student who demonstrates behavior unreasonably distracting to the driver which may contribute to unsafe operation. Complete disciplinary procedures are distributed annually and are available at each school or the Transportation Office.

Disciplinary Procedures

When, in the opinion of the driver, a serious rule violation occurs, or when the driver's efforts to deal with less severe violations are unsuccessful, or a pattern seems to have developed, a school bus incident report will be initiated. The intent is to maintain good order and a safe environment for students riding buses to and from school or school sponsored activities, as well as to notify parents of the misconduct of their children.

- The following are standard actions that will generally be applied uniformly in response to documented incidents.
 - o 1st / 2nd Offense: Student counseled and warned by driver.
 - 3rd Offense: Suspension of bus privileges for three days. (If within 45 days)
 - 4th Offense: Suspension of bus privileges for five days. (If within 45 days)

 5th Offense: Suspension of bus privileges for ten days or more, depending upon nature of the offense. (If within 45 days)
 The building administration will determine the extent of the suspension.

Note:

Serious offenses, such as fighting, flagrant displays of disrespect toward a driver, or possession of drugs or alcohol will result in immediate loss of bus privileges for a minimum of five (5) school days. Assault on a bus driver will result in indefinite suspension of bus riding privileges and possible criminal charges. If a violation occurs more than 45 calendar days after a previous violation, the disciplinary action will be the same as for the previous offense. There may be some exceptions to these disciplinary actions in extraordinary circumstances, as determined by the Transportation Director and the appropriate school principal. If a student is suspended for misconduct on any bus, the suspension will apply to all buses.

The administration recommends the Board adopt Resolution No. 2020-04 Emergency Waiver of High School Graduation Credits as presented.

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-04

A RESOLUTION FOR THE EMERGENCY WAIVER OF HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION CREDITS

WHEREAS, Chapter 28A.320 RCW authorizes local school boards to govern their respective districts, including adopting, revising, and suspending local board policies;

WHEREAS, Chapter 28A.230.090 authorizes the State Board of Education to set graduation requirements and authorizes local districts to decide whether a student has met the graduation requirements.

WHEREAS, the Eastmont School District Board of Directors ("Board") has adopted Policy 2410 High School Graduation Requirements, which establishes that the Board will establish graduation requirements that at a minimum satisfy those established by the State Board of Education.

WHEREAS, the Board has adopted and, as appropriate, implemented Policy 2418 Waiver of High School Graduation Credits, which authorizes the Superintendent or designee to grant waivers of a maximum of two elective credits required for high school graduation based on an individual student's circumstances.

WHEREAS, sections 10 through 12, chapter 7, Laws of 2020 (EHB 2965) authorized the State Board of Education to administer an emergency waiver program, which program is separate from and in addition to the waiver of two elective credits addressed in Policy 2418 Waiver of High School Credits, and expires on July 31, 2020. The purpose of the emergency waiver program is to grant local school districts with flexibility so that students in the graduating Class of 2020 or earlier who were on track to graduate before the gubernatorial declaration of emergency of February 29, 2020, are not negatively impacted by the response to the novel coronavirus (COVID-19). The emergency waiver may include both core credit graduation requirements and flexible credit graduation requirements.

WHEREAS, the Board wishes to ensure for any District students in the graduating Class of 2020 or earlier who were on track to graduate before the gubernatorial declaration of emergency and who would be negatively impacted by response to COVID-19, that the District comply with Chapter 180-111 WAC, which constitutes the State Board of Education's emergency waiver program.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Eastmont School District Board of Directors hereby authorizes the Superintendent or designee to implement an emergency waiver program consistent with WAC 180-111 as the Superintendent or designee determines appropriate. The District will demonstrate a good faith effort, as defined in WAC 180-111-020,

to help individual students meet credit-based graduation requirements through other options. The District will consult with the individual student, and make a reasonable effort to consult with a parent or guardian of the student, and will make a reasonable effort to provide information about this waiver in the preferred languages of the student, and of the parent or guardian of the student if applicable. This information includes what is being waived for the individual student, potential benefits and limitations that could result from receiving the waiver, including impacts on high school graduation and postsecondary plans, the option for the individual student to decline the waiver and for the student to be provided with the opportunity to earn the credits needed to complete graduation requirements through continued enrollment beyond the planned graduation date. The District will maintain a record of courses and requirements waived as part of the individual student record and will report to the State Board of Education.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the District will consider equity in administering the emergency waiver. This consideration will seek to identify and mitigate potential disparate impacts of the emergency waiver and determine if any changes to the District's approach in administering the emergency waiver are needed before the conclusion of the 2019-20 school year.

WORLD LANGUAGES

The Eastmont Board of Directors recognizes the value of preparing students to be global citizens with the skills to communicate in English and other world languages. In our state's diverse communities, it is not unusual for students to have various opportunities to develop language skills, for example, by using the language at home, attending language programs offered in the community, learning online, or living abroad.

The District will encourage students and their families to take advantage of any language learning opportunities available to them.

To enable students to fully benefit from the advantages of multilingualism, the District will encourage students to learn to understand, speak, read, and write at a high level of language proficiency. Proficiency can also be demonstrated in languages that are only spoken or signed.

In order to recognize the language proficiency of students, the Superintendent is directed to develop procedures for awarding world language credits to students based on demonstrated proficiency across a range of language skills.

EQUIVALENCY CREDIT OPPORTUNITIES FOR CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION COURSES

A. Experiential Education Opportunities

The District may grant credit, including high school graduation credit, for school planned or approved learning experiences which may be conducted away from the facilities owned, operated, or supervised by the District or conducted primarily by individuals not employed by the District.

To grant credit for such experiences, a proposal for approval of credit must be submitted to the District's designated team.

The proposal will include the following elements:

- 1. Name of program or planned learning experience;
- 2. Length of time for which approval is desired;
- 3. Objectives of the program or planned learning experience;
- 4. Which one or more of the state learning goals and related essential academic learning requirements are part of the program or planned learning experience;
- 5. Description of how credits shall be determined (completion of a Districtdefined course or satisfactory demonstration of proficiency or competency in the related state learning standards in accord with WAC 180-51-050(1));
- 6. Content outline of the program and/or major learning activities and instructional materials to be used:
- 7. Description of how student performance will be assessed;
- 8. Qualifications of instructional personnel;
- 9. Plans for evaluation of program; and
- 10. How and by whom the student will be supervised.

Approved experiences may include, but are not limited to, the following: School planned or approved learning experiences such as travel study, work study, private lessons, and education programs sponsored by governmental agencies.

B. Career and Technical Education Courses Provided by the District
Until September 1, 2021, the District will provide offer high school students with the opportunity to access at least one career and technical education course that is considered a statewide equivalency course as determined by the office of the superintendent of public instruction (OSPI) under RCW 28A.700.070.

On or after September 1, 2021, any statewide equivalency course offered by the District or accessed at a skill center will be offered for academic credit.

The District may also adopt local course equivalencies for career and technical education courses that are not on the list of courses approved by OSPI under RCW 28A.700.070.

The high school will adopt core academic course equivalencies for high school career and technical courses, provided that the career and technical course has been reviewed and approved for equivalency credit by a district team appointed by the superintendent or a designee.

The District team will include a school administrator, the career and technical administrator, an instructor from the core academic subject area, an instructor from the appropriate career and technical course, a school counselor, and a representative from the curriculum department.

Career and technical courses approved for equivalency will be:

- 1. Aligned with the state's essential academic learning requirements and grade level expectations; and
- 2. Aligned with current industry standards, as evidenced in the curriculum frameworks. The local career and technical advisory committee will certify that courses meet industry standards.
- 3. Recorded on the student's transcripts as the academic course the equivalence credit fulfills.

C. Computer Science Courses

1. AP Courses

The Board will approve Advanced Placement (AP) computer science courses as equivalent to high school mathematics or science. The superintendent or designee will adopt procedures to denote on the student's transcript that AP computer science qualifies as a math-based quantitative course for students who complete it in their senior year.

2. Competency-based credits

The District may award academic credit for computer science to students based on student completion of a competency examination that is aligned with the state learning standards for computer science or mathematics and course equivalency requirements adopted by the office of the superintendent of public instruction (OSPI).

To receive competency-based credits for computer science, a student must take a competency examination that OSPI has found aligns with the state learning standards for computer science or mathematics and that aligns with course equivalency requirements adopted by OSPI. The number of credits awarded will be based on the student's performance on the competency examination.

The competency examination must be offered in a proctored setting with appropriate technology. The District will approve the site(s) where the examination is offered, which could include individual schools, district buildings, community colleges, universities, education service districts, or other community settings. The District will award credit based on the highest examination score.

The District will receive official test results for each student who takes a competency examination. The District will provide a letter to the student with a copy of the test results and an indication of how many credits the student will be awarded. Credits awarded will be recorded on the student's transcript with a grade of "Pass".

In awarding academic credit for computer science, the District will follow the course equivalency approval procedure described above for career and technical courses.

3. Courses taken before attending high school

The District will award high school credit for computer science courses taken before attending high school if either of the following occurs:

- a. The course was taken with high school students, if the academic level of the course exceeds the requirements for seventh and eighth grade classes, and the student has successfully passed by completing the same course requirements and examinations as the high school students enrolled in the class; or
- b. The academic level of the course exceeds the requirements for seventh and eighth grade classes and course would qualify for high school credit because the course is similar or equivalent to a course offered at a high school in the District determined by the Board.

Students who have taken and successfully completed high school courses under the circumstances above will not be required to take an additional competency examination or perform any other additional assignment to receive credit.

Subject: Monthly Budget Status Report – March 2020

The information contained in this report is for the fiscal beginning September 1, 2019 through March 31, 2020. A brief summary of each fund's operating revenue and expenditures is provided below (NOTE: AS THE COVID CLOSURE EVENT TOOK PLACE ON 3/18/2020, THE FISCAL EFFECTS OF ARE NOT REFLECTED IN THIS REPORT):

General Fund:


- Year to date revenues are \$733,334, or 2%, less than the prior year.
 - Property tax collections through this month are \$1.1 million less than what was received at the same time last year. This will increase with collections in calendar year 2020 because the legislative change will allow the District to collect the full voter approved amount.
 - Apportionment and state categorical funding continues to trend less than the prior year because the State Legislature adjusted the apportionment allocation schedule to shift 2% of our allocation to July 2020. We used to receive 59.5% of our allocation through February. The new schedule allocated 57.5% of funds through March.
- Year to date expenditures are \$2.2 million or 5%, more than the previous year. The largest increase is in salaries and benefits, which are \$2 million more than the prior year. Employee compensation is 85% of year to date total expenditures.
- Fund Balance: Fund balance at the beginning of this fiscal year was \$2.9 million more than estimated when the budget was developed.
 - We expect revenues to be slightly more than estimated as a result of better than expected student enrollment and expect expenditures to be 98% of budget.
 - We estimate that total year end fund balance will be approximately \$14.7 million, which is \$3.0 million more than projected for the 2019-2020 budget.




- Year to Date revenues are \$190,907 more than anticipated due to higher than anticipated investment earnings.

Students in Grades 5th-7th

Students in grades 5-7 will be challenged to demonstrate effort and success in learning standards established by their teachers. All students will move on to the next grade, unless by mutual agreement between parents/guardians and teachers they agree to repeat a grade or a portion of learning missed.

Students in Grades 8th-12th

a. All students in grades 8-12 will be graded off the following standards (this includes any 7th grade students taking Algebra 1):

<u>Incomplete</u>	Pass (A on Transcript)
The student did not engage.	The student engaged in learning to the extent possible given their situation.

- b. No student will receive a "pass," "fail," or "no credit" grade for any course.
- c. Every class taken during the closure period will be given a statewide designator on the high school transcript to demote the unique environment in which the course was taken.

The administration recommends the Board adopt the enclosed Policy 3224 Student Dress.

STUDENT DRESS

The Eastmont School Board expects student dress and grooming to reflect high standards of personal conduct so that each student's appearance promotes a positive, safe, and healthy atmosphere within the school. Further, we hope to instill the understanding of, and adherence to, appropriate dress for a work environment as we prepare students for their future career. The District supports students dressing in a manner that is consistent with their gender identity and/or gender expression within the constraints of this policy and procedure.

Students' choices in matters of dress should be made in consultation with their parents.

Student dress will be regulated when, in the judgement of school administrators, there is a resonable expectation that:

- A. A health or safety hazard will be presented by the student's dress or appearance, including possible membership in a gang or hate groups;
- B. Damage to school property will result from the student's dress; or
- C. A material and substantial disruption of the educational process will result from the students' dress or appearance.

For the purpose of this policy, a material and substantial disruption of the educational process may be found to exist when a student's conduct is inconsistent with any part of the educational mission of the school district. Prohibited conduct includes the use of lewd, sexual, drug, tobacco or alcohol-related messages, and gang-related apparel.

Students and parents/guardians have the responsibility to be aware of this dress code and to conform to these requirements.

The uniforms of nationally recognized youth organizations, and clothing worn in observance of a student's religion, are not subject to this policy.

The superintendent will establish procedures providing guidance to students, parents and staff regarding appropriate student dress in school or while engaging in extracurricular activities. Such procedures will ensure that any student wearing, carrying, or displaying gang-related apparel, or exhibiting behavior or gestures which symbolize gang membership, or causing and/or participating in activities which intimidate or affect the attendance of another student will be asked, with notice to his or her parents, to make appropriate corrections and be subject to discipline if the corrections are not undertaken.
