


## <u>Summary</u>

The perceptions of our staff, students, and parents is an important indicator for us to know how effective we are as a district. Each fall, parents, students and staff are given the opportunity to rate the effectiveness of our schools. There is also a separate survey for staff to rate the District. These surveys are given during a two-week window that coincides with Parent-Teacher Conferences in late October. The surveys are used to learn and make improvements at each school and the District level.
