K-12 Non-Athletic Competitions for 2019-20

Eastmont High School

ASL	Students meet once per week, can attend a regional competition and qualifying students compete in a state competition. Put on "Sign Idol" annually.
Band	Large Group Contest: Bands perform as a class to receive judges' critique. Solo/Ensemble: Students compete as individuals/small groups for judges' critiques. Qualifying students may attend state competition.
Choir	Large Group Contest; Festivals in and out of state; students can audition for All-State Honor Choir; hosts "Voice of Eastmont." Solo/Ensemble - Students compete as individuals/small groups for judges' critiques. Qualifying students may attend state competition.
Debate	Meets after school twice a week. Qualifying individuals/teams may attend a state competition.
FBLA	Meets once per week. Students can go to regional, state, and national competitions.
FCCLA	Meets every other week. Students can compete in events at the regional, state, and national levels.
FFA	Meets once per week. Students compete at a regional conference. Qualifying students may attend state competition.
Knowledge Bowl	Meets twice per week during competition season. Students compete in periodical competitions. Qualifying teams may attend a state competition.
Mariachi & Orchestra	Large Group Contest: Orchestras perform to receive judges' critique. Solo/Ensemble: Students compete as individuals/small groups for judges' critiques. Qualifying students may attend state competition.
Skills U.S.A.	Meets once per week during competition season. May attend state/national competitions if teams/individuals qualify.
Sports Medicine	Students meet once a week before school during the few months before the competition. Qualified students attend the state competition each year.

Band	Large Group Contest: Bands perform as a class to receive judges' critique. Solo/Ensemble: Students compete as individuals/small groups for judges' critiques. Qualifying students may attend state competition.
Choir	Large Group Contest: Choirs perform as a class to receive judges' critique. Solo/Ensemble: Students compete as individuals/small groups for judges' critiques. Qualifying students may attend state competition.
FBLA	Meets once per week. Students compete at a regional conference. Qualifying students may attend state competition.
FFA	Meets once per week. Students can go to regional/state competitions.
Mariachi & Orchestra	Large Group Contest: Orchestras perform to receive judges' critique. Solo/Ensemble: Students compete as individuals/small groups for judges' critiques. Qualifying students may attend state competition.
Math is Cool	Meets once per week with both individual and team competitions. Qualified students may attend state competition.
Skills U.S.A.	Meets once per week during competition season. May attend a state competition if teams/individuals qualify.

Middle Schools: Clovis and Sterling (Intermediate grades)

Band	Large Group Contest: Bands perform as a class to receive judges' critique. Solo/Ensemble: Students compete as individuals/small groups for judges' critiques. Qualifying students may attend state competition. Apple Blossom Youth Parade: Marching Band competes against similarly aged groups
Choir	Large Group Contest: Choirs perform as a class to receive judges' critique. Solo/Ensemble: Students compete as individuals/small groups for judges' critiques. Qualifying students may attend state competition.
Math is Cool	Meets after school with both individual and team competitions. Qualifying students may attend state competition.
First Robotics	Meets after school in the fall to practice for and compete in the regional competition.

Elementary schools: Cascade, Grant, Kenroy, Lee, and Rock Island

Eastmont STEM	Participation is open to all students in the designated grade level: K-1 st grade — Straw Towers 4 th grade — Rube Goldberg 2 nd grade — Egg Drop 5 th grade — K'NEX 3 rd grade — Recycled Vehicles 6 th grade — Catapults
First Robotics	Meets after school with team competition/exhibition with all elementary teams within the district.
Math is Cool	Meets after school with both individual and team competitions. Qualified students may attend state competition.
